She also recalled that she went into a transaction with [REDACTED] to purchase a pickup style vehicle that she believed belonged to [REDACTED]. She stated that she had paid [REDACTED] \$200.00 for the truck, but on the day that he was moving [REDACTED]'s property out an older gentleman (believed to be ROBERT ARMSTRONG) and a younger man matching the description of ROBBIE SIMPSON had responded at which time [REDACTED] gave her money back and told her that he had promised the truck to the young man believed to be ROBBIE SIMPSON. At this time she did observe the vehicle to be driven away by these two people.

***GUN IDENTIFICATION:

Reporting detective at this time placed three handguns on the table one being the weapon used in the suicide, number two being turned over by [REDACTED] indicating that was the gun he got from the apartment, and then number three will be a 40 cal. Glock black in color being reporting detective's duty weapon. At this time reporting detective asked [REDACTED] if she recognized any of the weapons. She immediately pointed out the weapon used in the suicide indicating that was the gun that she saw [REDACTED] having at the table. She stated the other revolver style pistol was too big and she had never seen it before and then reporting detective's Glock was the wrong kind of model being semi automatic. She did identify positively the weapon used for the suicide as being the one that was in [REDACTED] apartment.
